

BEACH MANAGEMENT POLICY

The Peñíscola City Council wishes to contribute to the improvement of the environment of the municipality's beaches, since we are aware that they represent one of the most important natural values of the town and a huge attraction for all visitors to our municipality. With this we intend to make tourism growth compatible with adequate preservation of natural resources and the Environment in the area of the municipality's beaches, as well as satisfy the needs and expectations of the different interested parties.

That is why this City Council assumes the commitment to work for the protection of the Environment by providing quality services on the beaches, and ensuring that all the staff involved value and participate in the efforts carried out in this regard.

Within the framework of this commitment, all our actions will be governed by a POLICY based on the following commitments.

COMMITMENTS:

1. Implement and maintain the requirements of a Management System in accordance with ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and ICTE Q Standards, continuously improving its effectiveness.
2. We will ensure that our activities and services are carried out in compliance with applicable legislation, as well as other commitments that the City Council may voluntarily acquire.
3. We will minimize the possible negative environmental effects of our activities and services, gradually introducing those techniques that allow:
 - A more rational use of resources.
 - The prevention of waste, noise, discharges and emissions, or the reduction of these.
4. We will promote knowledge and responsibility towards the Environment and the satisfaction of the users of our beaches.
5. We will allocate the necessary resources to achieve the objectives and goals approved within the framework of this policy, with a firm commitment to continuous improvement.
